Genealogy Basics 1 - 4:

New to genealogy? Then these free workshops are for you! Just 30 minutes long, Genealogy Basics are designed to introduce beginners to the language of genealogy, to help you find key source information and to provide you with a solid grounding to advance your research. They cover the following :

1. Church & Civil Records:

Start with what you know and work backwards using certificates and parish records. This workshop is a brief look at records associated with births, deaths and marriages, how to find them, what is contained in them and how to obtain certificates and parish records.

2. Wills & Probates:

A brief look at some of the records associated with probates, how to find a will and obtain a copy. The laws of inheritance and succession will also be discussed.

3. Census & Electoral Rolls:

A brief look at two important secondary sources for genealogists, where to find them and what to expect.

4. Immigration & shipping:

NZ is a nation of immigrants. Finding when your ancestors arrived can be a challenge. This workshop will identify sources that can help, including shipping registers, ships logs and newspapers.
